



## Family First in Education

### **Program:**

Family First in Education aims to improve the educational and family outcomes for participating Greenwich elementary school students enrolled at Hamilton Avenue, New Lebanon and Julian Curtiss elementary schools where the low-income population is rapidly growing, leaving more students eligible for the Free or Reduced Federal Lunch Program. Due to socio-economic challenges faced by low-income families, most of these students are also non-proficient in state standardized reading and math testing. Family First in Education utilizes a two generational approach focused on parent engagement and structured after school programming. By paying close attention to both parent and student needs, the program positively impacts overall family wellness, school and community engagement, academic growth in reading and math and social/emotional development, thereby impacting key causes of the achievement gap.

### **Supervisor:**

Program Supervisor – LCSW or LPCA

### **Intern Requirements:**

- Bachelor or Master level intern who can be supervised by an LMSW or LPC
- Full Time Intern (16 - 21 hours, depending on school program)
- Full year intern (September-May)
- Required days/hours:
  - Afternoon Hours, at least 2 days per week, 2-6pm
- Position is in-person and based out of the Greenwich location
- Reliable transportation

### **Internship Expectations:**

- Carry a caseload of up to 5 families: up to 12 students
- Facilitate student workshops monthly
- Research/compile up to date resources for students and families
- Creating content/curriculum for participants ages K-5
- Attending monthly case conferences
- Meet with supervisor weekly
- Attend Team meetings as scheduled
- Complete documentation as required by program
- Supervisor will complete all school documentation as required, including approval of hours, process recordings, etc.
